Deposits/Refunds

A deposit of \$100 must accompany all applications. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Please register early to reserve your spot. The balance due must be paid at registration on June 28th. Deposits are refundable minus a \$25 service charge until June 12th. After June 12th, refunds are available only if we are able to fill the space from the waiting list or a physician's statement indicates inability to participate. There will be no refunds for withdrawal or dismissal.

How is it organized?

On the first day of camp, all players will be placed on a team based on what you have registered for (Jr./Sr. Camp) Teams will progress through all volleyball skills and team skills together. We strive to keep a 5-1 camper: coach rates to ensure individual attention.

Carla DeShaw is beginning her fifth year as the Head Women's Volleyball coach at Cazenovia College. One of the most recognizable and successful coaches in the northeast, Coach Laidlaw has over 650 career wins at Canastota High School. Most recently, Coach Laidlaw took over at Mohawk Valley Community College in 1999, leading them to the Mountain Valley Conference title 8 out of the past 10 years. MVCC has qualified for NJCAA Region III competition the past ten years, winning the title in 2003 and 2004. MVCC qualified for nationals in Rochester, Minnesota in 2003 and 2004, placing 5th in 2004. Coach Laidlaw has been named Mountain Valley Conference "Coach of the Year" (1999, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2008) and NJCAA Region III "Coach of the Year" (2001, 2002, 2003, 2004).

Location
